The Youth Chorus of Kansas City is seeking a collaborative pianist for the 2021-2022 season. The successful candidate can demonstrate a willingness to connect with the YCKC community, exhibit positive and proactive communication, and have a genuine interest in working with grades 3-12 singers in educational and rehearsal settings.

Supervised by: Artistic Director, Ryan Main

Purpose of Position: To provide support for directors and students, direct choirs

Time Commitment: 2.5 hours per week plus events as scheduled

YCKC Mission: To teach, to inspire, and to empower young singers to be life-long music makers who seek excellence in everything they do.

Compensation: \$25 / hour + stipend

Requirements:

- Ability to play and perform advanced literature at a high level
- Professional communication in person and written communication
- Availability for Monday evening rehearsals and performances, general availability for dates [outlined here](#)
- Exhibit willingness to connect to the YCKC community

Responsibilities:

- Communicate with staff about scheduling conflicts as they arise, and assist in finding qualified substitutes
- Accompany two choirs in rehearsal and performance
- Other events as scheduled, including revue performances, tours, and additional performances as available
- Lead and accompany sectionals as needed
- Prepare accompaniment recordings as needed
- Respond to e-mail and phone communications in a timely fashion
- Meet as needed with staff
- Provide other assistance as requested and agreed upon
